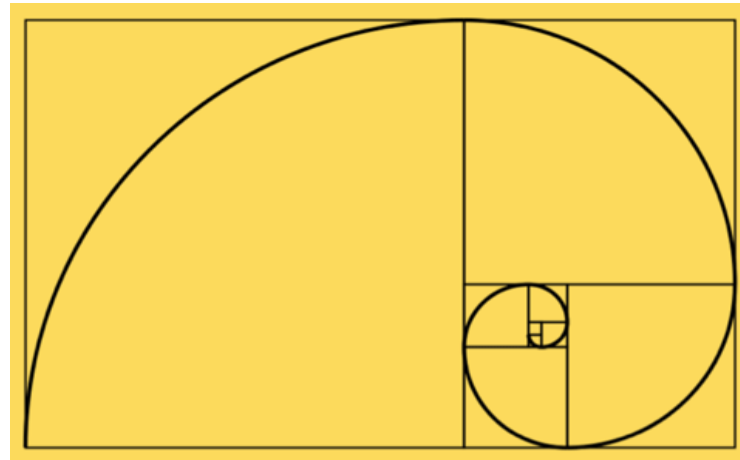


THE GOLDEN RATIO IN ROME

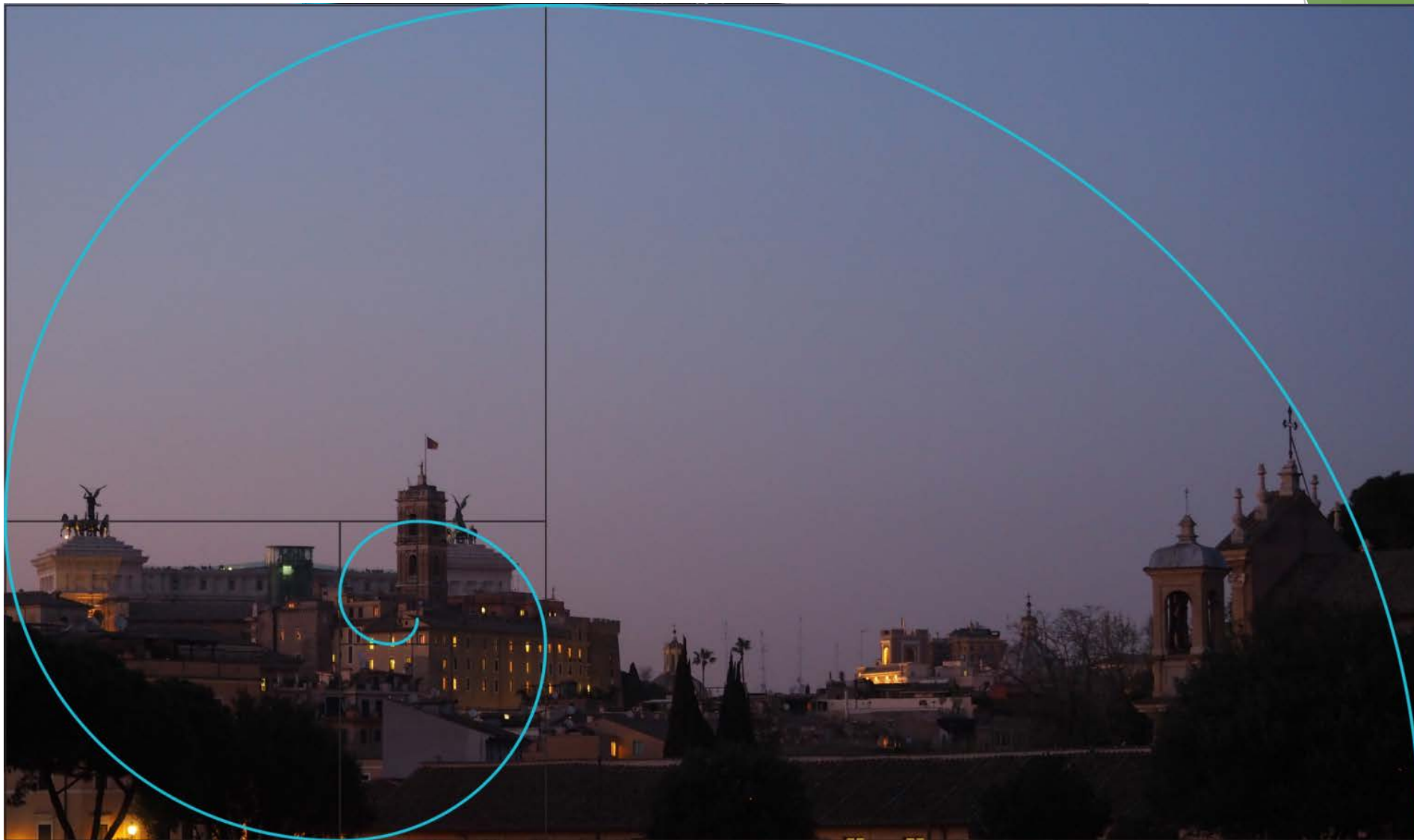
The picture shows the “House of the Knights of Rhodes” at the “Forum of Augustus”. The flag is in the center of the golden section. This building used to be a monastery but now it is used by the “Sovereign Military Order of Malta”.





The picture, taken from near “Roman Forum”, shows the Capitoline Hill. The center of the golden section is the tower, which was built during the late 16th century.





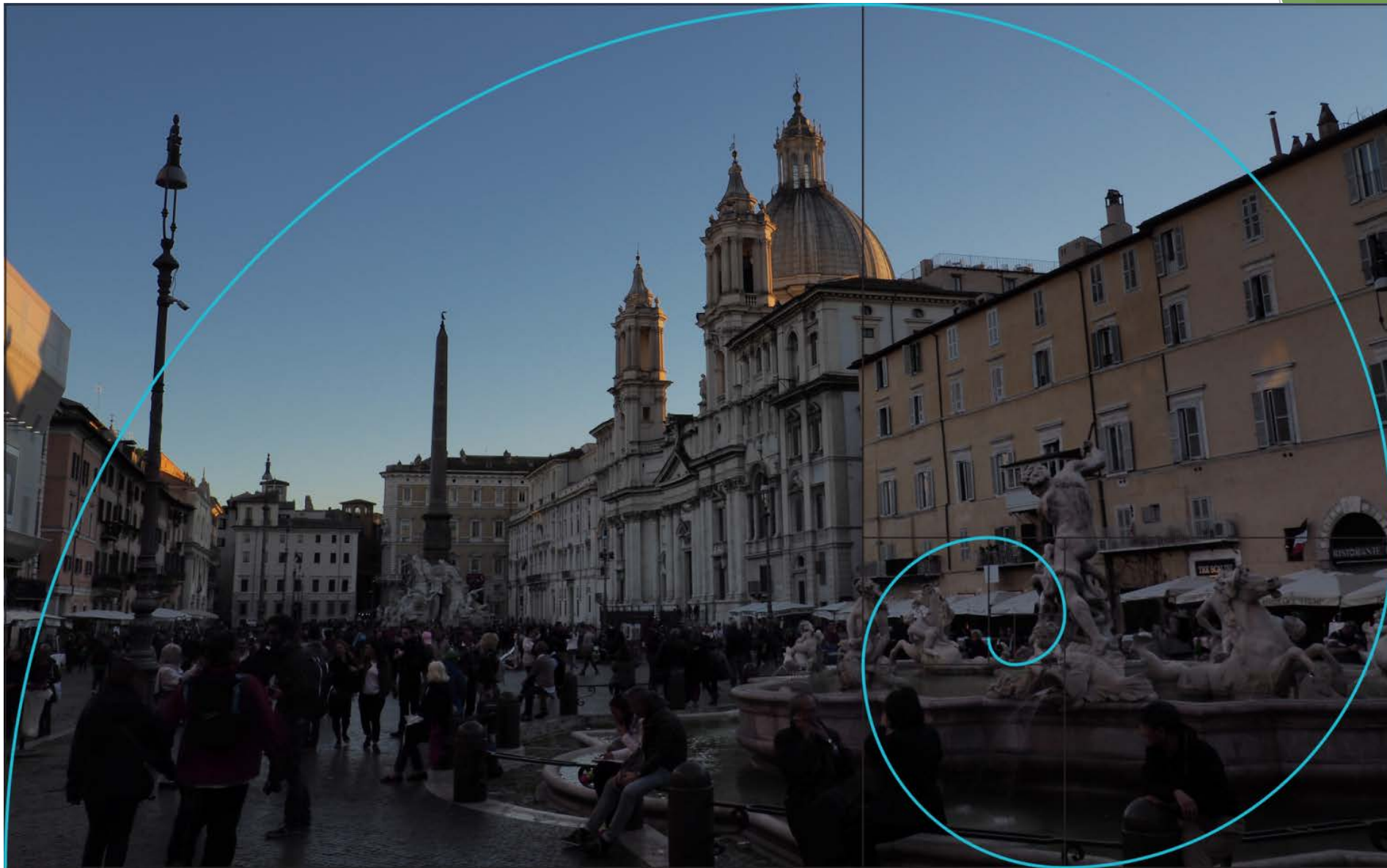
This picture shows the Capitoline Hill too but from a different perspective. In fact this picture was shot from behind, near the Aventine Hill. The center of the golden section is the same tower. This time we can see the “The Altar of the Fatherland” monument behind the tower.





This is another view of the Capitoline Hill at Piazza Venezia. In the center of the golden section we can see the big statue of the “Vittoriano” or “Altar of the Fatherland” monument.





This picture was taken at “Piazza Navona”. The “Fountain of the Four Rivers” is in the center of the golden section. This monument was made by Gian Lorenzo Bernini, one of the greatest artists of the Italian Baroque period.
