### **TOWN HALL IN VALENCIA, SPAIN**

*The Town Hall is made up of two connected blocks: the old Mayoral School and the section that was added by the architects Francisco de Mora y Berenguer and Carlos Carbonell Pañella at the beginning of the XX century. The first block is characterised by its academic design, including baroque features on the front doors, while the newer part combines more traditional and mannerist styles. The City Council has been based there since 1934, and the building also houses the municipal archives, a museum, and various offices of the administration.*

### **CHURCH SAINT-NICOLAS. COMBLOUX**

*Built between 1702-1704, in the Baroque style of the Alps, the church of Combloux is dedicated to St Nicolas.*

*The steeple, which was destroyed during the French revolution and was entirely rebuilt in 1828, is remarkable for its stainless steel facing. Also to be noted is the 18th century retablo in polychromatic wood which was restored by the Beaux Arts in 1970. Both the steeple and the retablo are classed as national monuments.*

## VITTORIANO
